

## “VISIONS TO VENTURES”

### FACT PROJECT GRANTS

- The “Visions to Ventures” Project Grants are designed to provide financial support to FACT members for a variety of activities in the areas of community and small business projects. Examples of projects include community or neighborhood revitalization projects, projects promoting partnerships and affiliations between businesses and schools, consumer education and counseling service projects, support for organizations and small businesses which provide essential services to their communities that are not otherwise available and projects to create or improve community or school recreation facilities.
- Awards vary in amounts ranging from \$100.00 to \$2,500.00 and will be made based on funding availability and the needs of the specific proposal.
- Only FACT members and their immediate family members may submit an application. One proposal per family, per year. Award checks will be issued only to a FACT member or to the FACT member’s designated qualifying organization.
- The Visions to Ventures Grants Review Committee will review and evaluate applications quarterly. All proposals received in the FACT management office between January 1 and March 31 will be reviewed in April. All proposals received between April 1 and June 30 will be reviewed in July. All proposals received between July 1 and September 30 will be reviewed in October. All October 1 – December 31 proposals received will receive January consideration. All applicants will be promptly notified of the committee’s decision on their application by the end of the appropriate review month.
